Important Information

- Entries must be received in advance by **5:00pm on Friday 11 September 2026**.
- Completed entry forms may be returned by email to clerk@caytonparishcouncil.gov.uk or by post to Jubilee Hall.
- All exhibitors and participants must register before taking part in the event.
- Children and young people under 16 years of age must be registered by a parent or legal guardian.
- Children under 11 years of age must be accompanied throughout the event by a responsible adult aged 18 years or over.
- Parents, guardians and carers remain responsible for the supervision, safety and welfare of their children at all times.
- Participants must follow all instructions and directions given by event organisers and volunteer stewards.
- Participants are expected to exercise reasonable care for their own safety and the safety of others.

- The main First Aid Point will be located at the Judges Table.
 - Any lost child, vulnerable person, welfare concern or safeguarding issue should be reported immediately to the Judges Table or the nearest steward.
 - The organisers reserve the right to refuse participation or remove any participant whose behaviour is considered unsafe, inappropriate or who fails to follow event instructions.
 - The organisers reserve the right to amend, postpone or cancel the event if weather conditions or other unforeseen circumstances make it unsafe or impractical to proceed.
