1. **Notice of meeting** –It was **RESOLVED** that the meeting was being held in accordance with schedule 12 para (10)2 (b) of the Local Government Act 1972. **57/26**
2. **Apologies** had been received from Councillors J Seaward & Manders, it was **RESOLVED the apologies be accepted.** **58/26**
3. **Declarations of Interests:** Councillor Swiers in provision of a contractor in respect of agenda item 10. The declaration was noted.
4. **Public Participation:** No public present.
5. **Minutes** of the meeting held 24th February 2026. It was **RESOLVED the minutes be approved & were signed.** **59/26**
6. **McCain John Young Centre provision of defibrillator.** A report had been circulated prior to the meeting with information of relevant to provision of a defibrillator at the venue. After discussion it **was RESOLVED that the decision be referred to Full Council*.** **60/26**

7. **Shrub bed bottom Chapel Lane** - Councillor Lockyer reported that NYC have been and cleared the cut down vegetation.
8. **Community Payback** - Councillor Swiers was thanked for meeting the Community Payback team and for opening the Jubilee Hall each Saturday. Councillor Swiers reported that the Jubilee Hall arch door has been sanded, filled and painted, along with the hallway and work had started on the disabled toilet. The team has also undertaken work in the churchyard, clearing the path; once materials are purchased, a membrane will be laid in the gravel area to reduce weeds. Forthcoming tasks include clearing and weeding various ginnels in Cayton and sanding and painting the sheds at the Jubilee Hall. Councillor Swiers invited councillors to suggest any additional suitable tasks for the Community Payback team.
9. **Bins – the following were discussed and decided:**
 - **The Orchard** – Councillors Liley and Swiers had met with Craig Lyon NYC and discussed provision of a bin for inside The Orchard and Shelly Close field. It was **RESOLVED to purchase a bin at a cost of £468 plus annual emptying cost x2.** **61/26**
 - **Harford Road** - the bin on will now be moved near the bench up the road.
 - **Green Belt** – bin to be repaired as NYC responsibility.
 - **Main Street**, adjacent to the Orchard will be replaced as NYC responsible.
10. **Piece of Fencing at The Orchard** – Information provided at the meeting was discussed. It was **RESOLVED that Dave Swiers will repair the missing section of fencing at a cost of up to £50.00.** **62/26**

11. **Shelley Close Field** – Information was discussed about a resident request. After discussion **it was RESOLVED that the Council will not proceed with installation of gates at this time.** 63/26
12. **Cemetery Gates** – the gates are in need of painting. Councillor Swiers reported that it is on the list for the Community Payback team to complete.
13. **Any other Business** – Councillor Lockyer reported that the wooden benches needed painting and that the first cut by North Yorkshire Council (NYC) has been undertaken. Councillor Green reported he had received an estimate of £27,000.00 to extend the gutter pipe adjacent to the Community Land. Councillor Swiers reported that campervans and BBQs were still an ongoing problem at Cayton Bay and is continuing to work with NYC to come up with practical solutions since the signage was removed during the night.
